

What You Need to Know About the NH Vaccine Rollout

Who Qualifies for the Vaccine

Phase 1B includes:

- People **65 years or older**
- **Medically vulnerable** at *significantly* higher risk with 2 or more conditions (see a list at <https://www.vaccines.nh.gov/>) as well as family caregivers of those medically vulnerable persons (**16 and under not eligible at this time**).
- **Residence and staff of residential facilities** for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
- **Corrections officers and staff** working in correctional facilities
- **First responders and healthcare workers** not already vaccinated.

What Documents Should I Bring to My Appointment

- Valid **NH drivers license** or ID Card
- **Lease or Rental Agreement**
- Current **utility bill**
- **Payroll check**
- **Property tax or real estate bill**
- A **government check or document** issued by an official in the municipality of a NH town or city within the last 60 days.
- A **mortgage statement** within the last 60 days
- A **title application** by the town clerk or tax collector - cannot be marked non-resident

How Do I Register

You can register online at www.vaccines.nh.gov or call **211** for information on how to register if you do not have computer access. If you are using a **TTY service** you can call **711**
