What You Need to Know About the NH Vaccine Rollout

Who Qualifies for the Vaccine

Phase 1B includes:

- People 65 years or older
- Medically vulnerable at significantly higher risk with 2 or more conditions (see a list at https://www.vaccines.nh.gov/) as well as family caregivers of those medically vulnerable persons (16 and under not eligible at this time).
- Residence and staff of residential facilities for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

What Documents Should I Bring to My Appointment

- Valid **NH drivers license** or ID Card
- Lease or Rental Agreement
- Current **utility bill**
- Payroll check
- Property tax or real estate bill
- A government check or document issued by an official in the municipality of a NH town or city within the last 60 days.
- **Corrections officers and staff** working in correctional facilities
- First responders and healthcare workers not already vaccinated.
- A **mortgage statement** within the last 60 days
- A **title application** by the town clerk or tax collector - cannot be marked non-resident

How Do I Register

You can register online at www.vaccines.nh.gov or call 211 for information on how to register if you do not have computer access. If you are using a TTY service you can call 711
