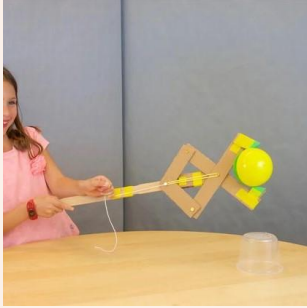

Beekeeping 101 with the Merrimack Valley

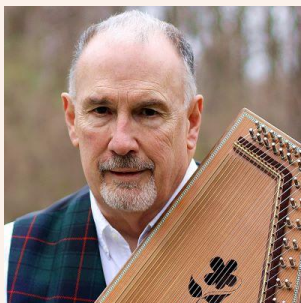
